# Lights

# Lock

Open doors and windows are open invitations to burglars. Thieves don't like a challenge. Simple window locks can put them off. Be sure all doors and windows are locked when you're home and especially when you're out. Thieves can open your front door from the inside using various objects through the letter-box. Always double-lock your door or get a letter-box guard. **Don't let the burglar walk right in...**

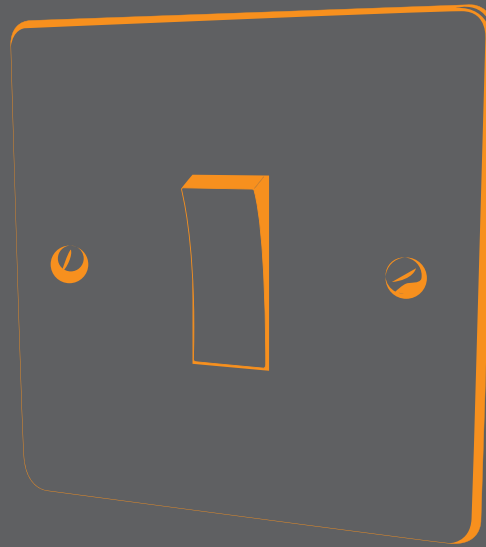
