Please Note:

The total number for Recorded Hate Crime does not include Racially or Religiously Aggravated Crime as these are counted in the crime figures.

Hate crime has been identified for offences where one or more of the five strands of Hate Crime qualifiers (race or perceived race, religion or perceived religion, sexual orientation or perceived sexual orientation, disability or perceived disability and transgender or perceived to be transgender) have been applied to the offence. Because one offence can contain multiple qualifiers the overall total may not equal the sum of the strands listed individually.

Data on page one relates to all valid crimes by Home Office Crime Group Category or Classification.

ASB data has been identified for all offences recorded under the Occurrence Types of ASB – Personal, ASB - Environmental and ASB - Community.

Domestic Abuse Victimisation data has been identified for all DA related Crimes where the Repeat Domestic Abuse qualifier has been applied to the offence.

Knife Enabled Crime Definition - Any valid crime recorded as Murder, Attempted Murder, Rape, Sexual Assault, Robbery, Threat to Kill and offences under GBH/ABH (codes 5D, 8N, 8P, 8S and 8T), where the knife crime qualifier has been applied to the offence.

The data provided is taken from our crime recording system. This is a dynamic system. Additional information identified during the investigation may lead to a reassessment of the crime classification. Information held on the system is also subject to review to ensure compliance with the Home Office Counting Rules for Recording Crime and the National Crime Recording Standard. As a result of this crime levels and classifications may change over time and this data may not match data previously published or data published in the future. For this reason, the data should only be used as an indicator of crime trends.
