

Report from S&SIAG 13 November 2019

We had a report from Retd Chief Supt Andy Boyd about the Serious Violence and Knife Crime project they are carrying out during January, February and March in the 6 large towns in TVP area. This will include Community workshop events to try to engage young people who would normally not engage.

Stop and Search

We looked at figures for April to September 2019 and S & S figures are overall 56% higher than the same period last year, back to 2015 levels with an average of 33 per day.

Wycombe carried out 533 searches which is 29% up from the same period 2018. Some areas of TVP have much higher increases (Milton Keynes, Windsor and Maidenhead); some much lower (Oxford, Reading).

Positive outcomes are 23.1% overall, Wycombe are 18.6%.

Overall 66% of searches were for drugs, in Wycombe this is 76%. Other searches were (in order) offensive weapons, stolen property and going equipped.

Section 60 searches were carried out in Slough, Milton Keynes and West Berkshire. 614 with 16 arrests, 5 cannabis warnings and 4 penalty notices for disorder.
