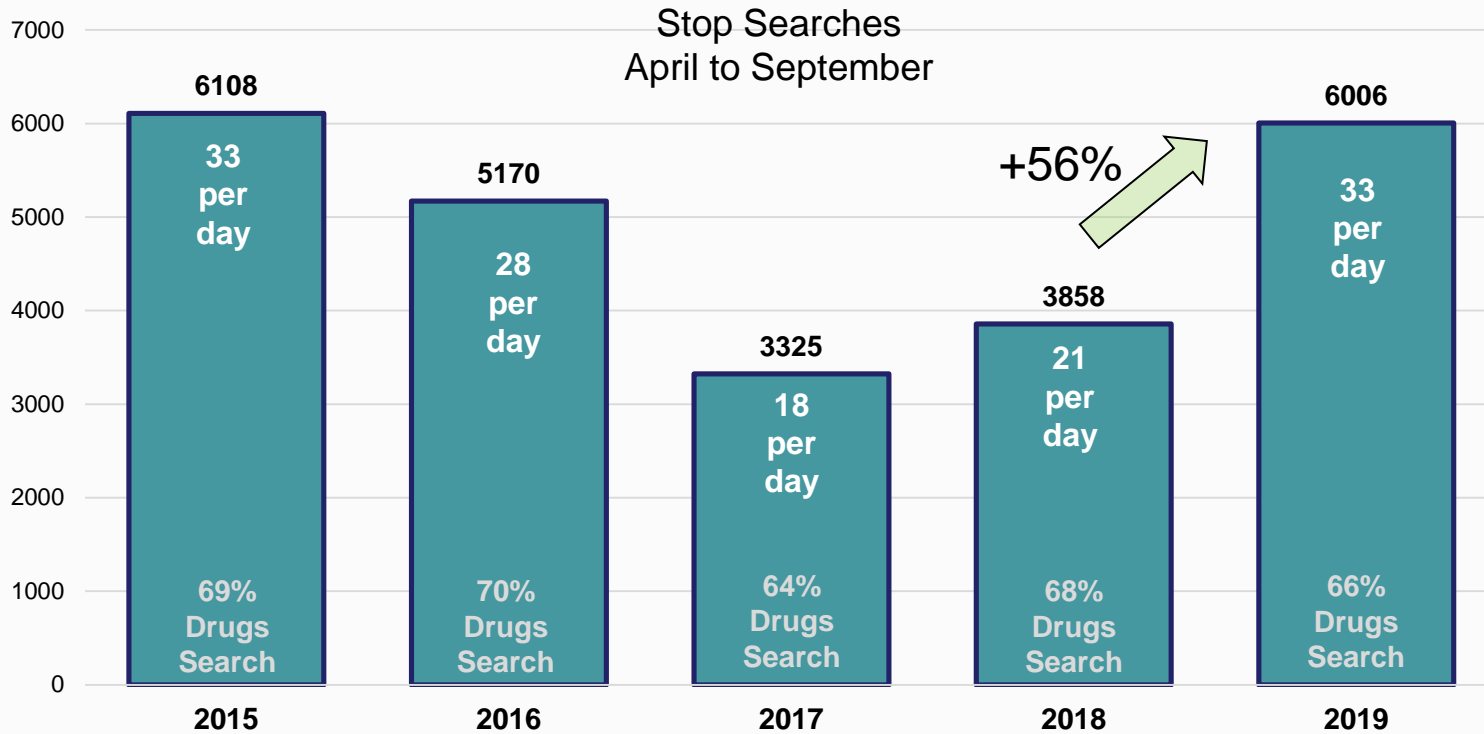

Officers have carried out 2,148 more searches than last year with considerable increases observed in many LPAs.

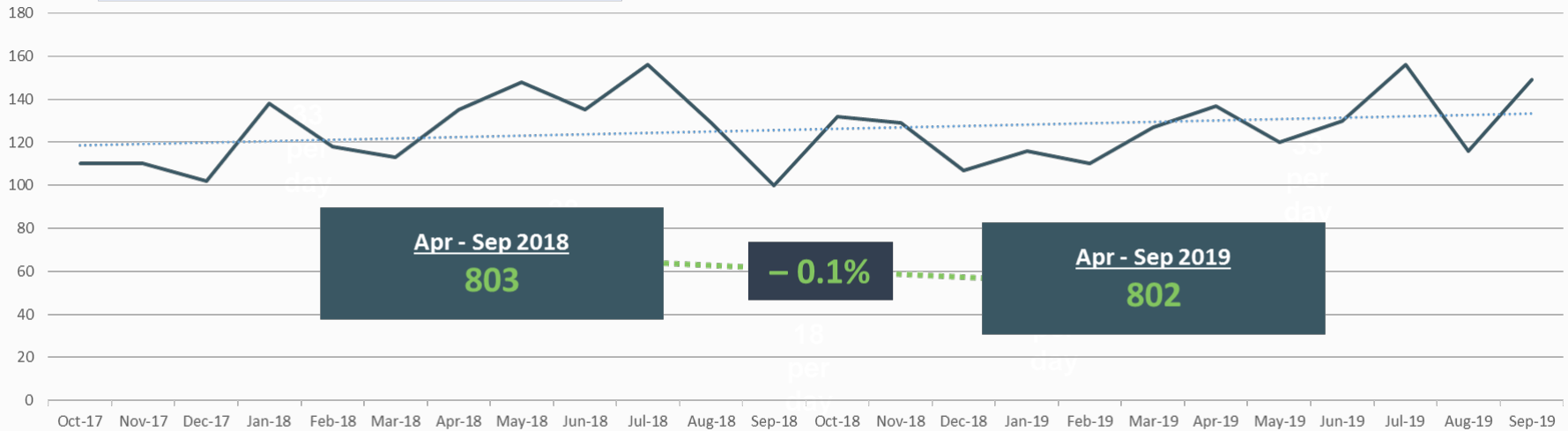
